- 1. the LC 50 value in the abstract of the hexane fraction of Z. zerumbet species does not match the data in table 1
- 2. conclusions shown are not the same as those in the abstract. conclusion adapted to the abstract.
- 3. conclusions did not consistently show the value of LC 50 from two different species and did not consistently show the value of LC 50 from two different species.
- 4. Information on secondary metabolite content in conclusion, it is better if it is shown the secondary metabolite content of each fraction for both plant species
