This paper uses generalisation in discussion and conclusion whic are not appropriate for this kind of research

Comments to the Author

The author makes a fine case in support of the need for a multi-stakeholder "integrated mentoring model" to support creative economy SMEs. However, the informant pool of 25 seems limited; what percentage of creative economy SMEs does this represent? Also, it might be more equitable to have a more equal weighting of informants per sector, and to better understand who these informants are, e.g., only 1 TV informant vs 6 Culinary and 5 Fashion; and is this a terrestrial, digital, or regional station; what are these other enterprises, i.e., does "culinary" mean restaurants, culinary schools; are the fashion informants boutiques, fashion influencers? Better understanding this pool will tell a more robust story of who these SMEs in the creative economy are and why their input is valuable.

An inclusion of the survey questions that was given to the representatives from these informants would also add depth and enhance our understanding of their responses. Admittedly, the responses themselves demonstrated a lack of understanding of the 5 segments that this integrated mentoring model states is sorely needed by these SMEs; so this does support the need for this mentoring model.

Also, further explain the application of the Penta Helix. The linear graph should illustrate the collaborative, iterative process that this model suggests. Also, how exactly is this model to be funded, managed, governed? How and who will identify/attract the academics, business mentors, local government designees, etc. And who will lead the creative community so it is an action-oriented community?

Addressing these questions would add depth to this paper. I'm convinced of the need, but would like to know the bigger story and how it will be realized.
