

1- the background section is too long. It is better to make this section shorter and expand the methodology and results

sections.

- 2- The first two sentences can be combined a one sentence.
- 3- Methods is written poorly. Please write e about study setting and period of study.
- 4- There is no information about two groups that were categorised in the main text. It should be written here "key informants" and "general informants".
- 5- Results should provide more information about different themes.

Conclusion is too long. It is better to make this section shorter and expand the methodology and results sections.

- 1- Please write "Javanese culture" instead of only "culture".
- 2- Please add "Indonesia".

Introduction:

1- First paragraph, lines 2-4 have been cited by reference 2. It is better to just use once. Please remove the first reference 2.

Method and design

- 1- It is not clear why snowball sampling was used for health workers and family member. The criteria to choose family members and health workers are not clear. Health workers are choosen form which health centre?
- 2- Study setting and process of recruiting patients is not clear. How did you recruited them?
- 3- The reason to choose health workers and family members is not clear. How they help you to get better results for this study?
- 4- Authors believe that to obtain a varied set of key participants, they selected them based on ...and gender. Why majority of participants (85%) are female?
- 5- Dividing participants to "Key participants" and "general participants" is confusing. Key participants are actually patients.
- 6- There is no nay information about data collection tool. What questionnaire was used? How it was developed? How about its translation process? Was it pilot tested?
- 7- Study procedure is not clear. How has conducted the interviews? Any bias in terms of gender differences between interviewer and interviewees as majority of participants were female? How about getting consent form for those participants who were not educated?
- 8- It is not clear how the authors reached the data saturation with the sample size of 47? Did they consider all three groups as whole or data is saturated for each group separately?
- 9- in "Data analyses", last paragraph needs references when you talked about thematic analysis.
- 10- How about bias in conducting interviews, collection data, emerging themes and sub-themes and interpreting results when the all authors had lived and grown up with the Javanese culture
- 11- Instead of using title "credibility of the study" please write "study rigorousness"

Results:

This section is written very well. There are few comments:

- 1- Line 1, please write "Table 1" using capital letter for T.
- 2- It so not clear where the results of "observation" and "field notes" were used in this section.
- 3- The number if quotations were used in this section is not representing on total participants.
