For example, if one habitat was sampled for a longer period, more species might automatically be found.
2. P values. It looks like you have run some good statistical analysis. However, the p values and test statistics are not clearly stated in your work. Please provide both the test statistics and p values for your tests.
3. Proof read. There are many errors in terms of english spelling and I have where possibel made suggestions for corrections. However, the paper would benefit from a full proof read, ideally from a native english speaker.

Many thanks for submitting this revised version of the manuscript for review. You have taken into account some of the feedback provided on the initial review of the paper. In future, please show clearly where revisions to the work have been made. This could be in the form of highlighted text or responses to reviewer comments.

There remain some comments which have not been addressed. In particular, it is still not clear how many hours of observation were conducted for each location, or what times of day each observation was undertaken. It is essential that this information is provided, as the number of hours / time of day / season will affect the number of gastropods and the species found.

Please also check the use of the term 'gastropods community' which does not make sense in English. This should be 'gastropod community' or 'gastropod communities', depending on the scenario. Please ensure this is adjusted throughout the manuscript.
