This study aims to map the stigma and analyze the gender dimensions according to access, role, benefit and control.

Transmission of HIV and AIDS becomes a serious problem in Banyumas Regency, one of them is in Cilogok and South Purwokerto sub-districts.

Material and methods

The research method of this research uses quantitative approach with cross sectional and qualitative approach. The population and sample taken in quantitative research are 193 people of fertile age couples (Couples of childbearing age) in Banyumas Regency from Cilogok and South Purwokerto sub-district. Data analysis used is paired t test.

Results

Based on the research most respondents aged 36-49 years is 66.33%. Men and women are almost equal, at 49.74% and 50.26%. Most of them have high education level 39,37%, not work equal to 53,88% while have amount of child equal to 67,87%. The results of the research shows that there is no stigma reduction role and gender equality improvement according to sex category between male and female. There are differences in role reduction stigma between urban and rural communities, and also differences in the role of gender equality improvement in urban and rural communities.

Conclusions

There are differences in role reduction stigma and also differences in the role of gender equality improvement between urban and rural communities. It is important to pay attention to residence area factor in the effort of implementing prevention program of HIV and AIDS. It can be related to the prevailing approaches to HIV and AIDS prevention policies and programs.
