"Regional Expansion: A Local Political Strategy in Indonesia"

Abstract

The political policies chosen by the central government in managing the relationship between the center and the regions make the regions always a strategy of exchange. This strategy is a continuation of the past linking the unity of Indonesia's independence with various traditional countries and links with communities that represent customs and religions in Indonesia. Inequality of development and unfair alignment of the distribution of resources for each region has become a national problem for Indonesia. This condition strongly triggers the desire to establish new areas to obtain definitive status to obtain development funds and power in the local area. The changing expansion policy is a form of inconsistency between the central and regional relations. It is even considered a limit to each community's will (regional and ethnic/ethnic). This study uses a qualitative method to obtain information related to the meaning of pemekaran/expansion. Information was obtained through in-depth interviews with informants from elements of the central and local government, political actors and the community. The secondary data used comes from various media and related ministries. This study found that, regional expansion is finally a strategy and effort of local communities to achieve political goals, namely existence and welfare through financing for development.

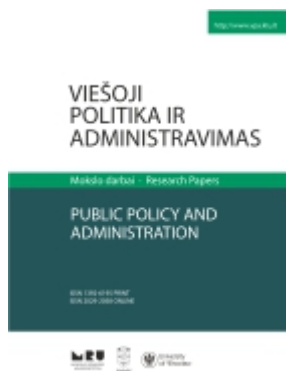

"Politic of Charisma: A Study on Political Authority of Tuanku in West Sumatra, Indonesia"

Abstract

This study aims to explain Tuanku's authority as a leader of the tarekat community which has significantly played a socio-political role in West Sumatra, Indonesia. By using descriptive-phenomenological method, in order to understand the meaning of Tuanku on various socio-political activities, the researchers conducted a FGDs with murshid and in-depth interviews to teacher and congregation of tarekat. Observations were made to study the charismatic authority of Tuanku in the dynamics of socio political community that is related to the teachings and religious understandings of tarekat in areas in which tarekat activities are practiced. This study elucidated facts; first, Tuanku has an important role and a strong influence on political dynamics of tarekat. Second, Tuanku's understanding on politics has its relation to the religious understanding of tarekat. Third, political attitude and behavior of tarekat community in West Sumatera show a charisma authority toward political choices of the tarekat community. This study is interesting in understanding the political attitude of Tuanku in the midst of the vortex authority and politic of charisma in the changing and unpredictable political dynamics in Indonesia. From examining a number of previous studies, researchers see that no similar study has examined the authority of the Tuanku charisma on the socio-political dynamics in West

Sumatra. This research has explained the Tuanku's charismatic authority on politics in West Sumatra.

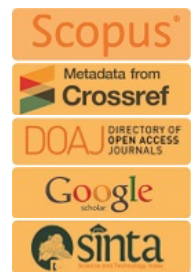

This study formulates ideas as a transformation agenda that needs to be done in Indonesia for the implementation of regional development planning in many critical areas that are problematic. Qualitative interpretation is carried out on in-depth understanding based on data obtained through interviews, documentation studies, and the direct involvement of authors in some development planning processes. Political and bureaucratic relations, harmonious interaction and integration processes in a decentralized governance system, interaction of functions and planning and evaluation methods as a development management cycle, and strengthening planning resources are areas that need to be prioritized to accelerate the transformation of regional development planning. Abstract

Objectives: The main aim of this study is to investigate how the issue of parental alcohol abuse related harm to children (PAHCh) is problematized in child protection and support processes. We focus on how the mental narratives of child protection and welfare professionals' (CPWPs) affect their work practices and results. **Methods:** The qualitative research was designed using Bacchi' problematization approach. Twenty in-depth semi-structured interviews were conducted with key CPWPs. Our aim was to look at the PAHCh behind the problems represented by practitioners. **Results:** The problematization of the PAHC is directly linked to parental intoxication, which is why parental sobriety is associated with the disappearance of the harm. Child support is treated through the provision of parental assistance. The primary aim of delayed or repeated separation of a child from their family is not to protect the child, but to correct parental behavior. CPWPs' practice with families has led to developing a specific work background whereby the child's life in a drinking family is indirectly normalized. At the same time, lower standards of child protection may be applied. The presumed result is 'visible but unprotected victims'. **Conclusion:** The problematization of PAHC must be seen as a significant aspect in analyzing institutional response and evaluating work performance.
